Attend the free Monitor Training SIG (1 hour approx.) to learn the duties. Check the Club Calendar for dates and times for that SIG.

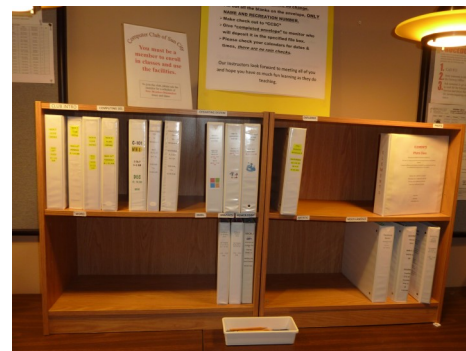

How to Sign up for Classes

Course binders are located in the Monitor Area across from the Monitor's desk, as you enter the Club.



Registration envelopes for courses are located in each course binder. Do **NOT** take the envelope home. If there are no envelopes left in a binder, that means the class is full. Many classes are offered at least once a month. Instructors may have a binder prepared for the next time they offer the class.

Student must bring a flash drive to class sessions.

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS! Be sure you are free to attend before signing up for a class. Envelope must be completed in the Computer Club, payment enclosed, and the envelope sealed. One envelope per student per course. Fee for all classes is \$5, no matter how many sessions are in the class.

Either a **check** or **correct change** is acceptable.

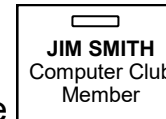

All New Member Applications are accepted by a CCSC Board Member or a Membership Team Member between 9 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on scheduled days only.

- Dues: \$15 per person per calendar year.
